Functions:**Terms of office of**

Members of Board: The terms of the office of all the members shall be two years.

Meeting: At least four times a year.

Function of the**Board of Governors:**

- a. The Governing Body of the institute is responsible for the general superintendence, direction and control of the affairs of the institute and shall exercise all the powers of the institute.
- b. Without prejudice to the provisions of sub-sections Governing Body shall:
 1. Take decisions on questions of policy relating to the administrations of the working of the institute.
 2. Introduce programs of study and approve intake to various programs.
 3. Make rules of service of the employees and consider, modify or delete the provisions in service rule for employees.
 4. Institute and appoint persons to academic as well as other positions in the institute.
 5. Consider and approve the annual report, the annual accounts and the budget of the institute for the next financial year.
 6. Have the power to perform such other duties and appoint such committees as it considers necessary and deemed fit for proper development and maintenances of academic standard and reputation of the institute.
 7. Institute scholarships, fellowships, medals, prizes and certificate on the recommendation of the head of the institute.
 8. Consider recommendation of the appropriate committees and head of the institute.
 9. Consider reward and promotions for faculty and staff on recommendation of the appropriate committees.
 10. Decide quantum of punishment to faculty or offices of the college on grounds of indiscipline on the basis of reports given by duly constituted committees and the head of the institute.
 11. Assess justification or necessity of foreign travel by faculty before giving approval.
