A. Feedback on Curriculum

The institution has always been in quest of quality education. The outcome based education has been implemented across all programmes and continue to refine it aiming at achievement of excellence. The data is analyzed and discussed the departmental academic committee for possible incorporation in the curriculum. A report has been submitted to the principal for subsequent action. Feedback on Infrastructural Facilities:

A good infrastructure, with renewed spaces, makes it possible to improve the attendance and interest of students and teachers in learning. Infrastructures play a significant rôle to improve the quality education and educational performance. A structure feedback has taken from the students to optimize the investment to enhance the infrastructural facilities in the campus.

End Semester Students Survey:

At the end of each semester, feedbacks are taken from students for individual courses with reference to teaching-learning processes and achieving the course outcomes. These feedbacks are used by the teachers to improve or strengthen the modes of delivery and contents of instructional matters. The Head of the Department is also consulted in this matter so that appropriate steps may be taken to improve/ strengthen the academic system.

Graduate Exit Survey:

The primary purpose is to obtain information about students' performance with a range of academic and co-academic experiences during graduation. Feedbacks are collected from the graduating students at the end of the final semester. The achievement of program outcomes and program specific outcomes are also taken as criteria in the feedback. The graduate exit survey helps to assess students' perception of how the course curriculum has advanced them toward their goals.

Alumni Survey:

Alumni feedback is taken with reference to the achievement of program educational objectives. Alumni surveys are conducted during alumni interaction at the alumni association meeting held every year on 23rd January. Alumni feedback is also taken whenever any alumnus visits the college and further, college website invites alumni to provide feedback through online.

Employer Survey:

The primary purpose is to measure the engagement level, experiences in working with and supervising our graduates. Students who have undergone vocational/summer training and internship in the industries, feedback is taken for the performance of students. Normally verbal feedback is taken from the concerned persons when our faculty meets them or when they come to department for giving lecture or training.

Guardian Survey:

The primary purpose is to obtain information about guardians' satisfaction with a range of academic, co-academic experiences, performances during and after graduation. This opinion is very valuable for significant improvements to the content and delivery of graduate education.

ACTION TAKEN ON FEEDBACK

The college follows a continuous review system as a measure of quality sustenance and quality enhancement. The feedbacks are collected by the concerned department, analyzed and discussed in the departmental academic committee meeting.
