Several nodes of rapid mass transport are present in the vicinity of the institute. They ensure quick and efficient travel to the college from the surrounding region. There are two bus termini and two suburban railway stations. There is one Metro railway station. The arterial Eastern Metropolitan Bypass is also near.

It is the matter of the "Last-Mile-Connectivity" (from these nodes) that has been the focus of the institute's initiatives to address locational advantages and disadvantages. The college has small fleet of vehicles (10~14-seaters) that ply to ferry the college staff to and from these nodes. A bus service was also arranged for the students on a subscription basis for the same purpose. The second part of this picture is the cooperation of the institute with the local authorities which has resulted in one auto-rickshaw route from the college to the suburban railway station and one e-rickshaw route to the Metro station. These have been a boon to the students and the local people alike. This cooperation further extends to the matter of expediting the regular maintenance of the roads connecting the college to these nodes. To this end, the college has made several direct and substantial financial contributions to the local authorities over the years. The third part of the picture pertains to the large number of outstation students that enrol every year. The college takes steps to ensure a smooth and hassle-free stay for the students for the duration of their study. The college authorities regularly interact with the owners of the local PG accommodations to ensure that the outstation students receive proper facilities at fair prices.


